### **EPA Accepts New Label Rates and Uses For Vista® Herbicide From Dow AgroSciences**

**INDIANAPOLIS** — The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency recently accepted a label update for the right-of-way maintenance product Vista® herbicide from Dow AgroSciences LLC.

The updated label includes a rate increase to 2 2/3 pints (42 fl. oz.) per acre per year and removes the annual broadcast treatment limitation of only one, allowing crews to make multiple applications of Vista every year. This selective, postemergence herbicide is now labeled for use on forestry plantations as well.

Research from Dow AgroSciences suggests the new label rate increases the ability of managers mixing Vista with products like Garlon® and Tordon® herbicides to improve control, even with applications that occur later in the season. The results are based on, and representative of, a wide variety of plant species and growing conditions existing nationwide.

“Our trials show that adding Vista herbicide to Garlon or Tordon noticeably increases the uptake of both products,” says Ron Cornish, customer agronomist for Dow AgroSciences. “This translates to improved control. We have really noticed this on later-season applications to pine and some hard-to-control oak species like shingle oak.

“While Vista herbicide alone will continue to provide excellent control of the invasive weed, kochia, several more troublesome species will be vulnerable to the increased label rate, including curly dock, ragweed, goldenrod, wild carrot and ironweed,” Cornish adds. “Plus, there are no grazing restrictions<sup>1</sup> with Vista.”

In the future, Dow AgroSciences anticipates offering Vista as straight product or custom mixes with Garlon or Tordon herbicides in the Continuum™ Prescription Control & Container Management System.
